

Bowls - Club Helensvale \$50,000 Henselite National Club 5 A Side Challenge

Broadbeach have continued their impressive form into day 2 of the Henselite \$50,000 National 5 a Side Challenge at Club Helensvale today. Boasting the youngest side in the 20 club strong competition including current Australian Under 18 rep Scott De Jong, Queensland under 18 rep Sean Ingham and led by recent Australian senior debutant Sean Baker.

They sit two games clear of Helensvale 1 who faltered in the afternoon games winning only one out of four matches.

Previous winners Taren Point were the big movers on day 2 jumping from eleventh after day 1 to sit in third place after today's action, one win behind the Helensvale outfit.

Defending champions Warilla held their form from day 1 and sit level on points with Taren Point with only margin keeping them in the fourth position.

Hot on the heels of the top four are South Tweed and Cabramatta who are both previous runner up teams in this event.

Interesting match ups on the third and final day of qualifying tomorrow include Taren Point versus Warilla and South Tweed who also play each other, Helensvale challenge Cabramatta and then square off with Broadbeach in the final round.

The top 4 teams after the final day of qualifying advance to Thursday's Semi Finals and Grand Final. With 8 qualifying games still to be played, there's opportunity for dramatic changes to the leaderboard.

Eleven teams still have a genuine chance of making the top 4 with Pine Rivers, Essendon, Raymond Terrace, Bargara and Grange all hot on the heels of the top 6 teams.
